Insurance Services Office (ISO) has submitted a recommendation concerning your community's Public Protection Classification (PPC). Currently, the Community's Public Protection Classification rating is not classified and therefore is rated as unprotected.

**Insurance Services Office is recommending the classification be changed to Class 3/10, with an effective date of 08/01/2010.** The recommendation is based on a review of your community performed on 11/02/2009 and does include application of the Texas Addendum.

With a split Class 3/10 rating, all class rated property located within 5 miles of a fire station, will use **Class 3**, whereas, all class rated property located farther than 5 miles of a fire station will use **Class 10**.


Public Protection Classifications range from 1 (best) to 10 (worst).

We have reviewed the information provided and believe it is sufficient to grant approval. We will notify Insurance Services Office of our approval of the recommendation and of the 08/01/2010 effective date.


