No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners (Limited to two minutes).]*

 3. Adopt a proposed 2021 Fiscal Year Budget. Commissioner Boatright
 4. Review the calculated 2020 tax rates for the District and adopt a proposed tax rate for the 2020 Tax Year and authorize publication and posting of all required tax notices under Truth and Taxation. Commissioner Boatright
 5. Commissioners will set a date for a Public Hearing on the Proposed Tax Rate to immediately be followed by a Special Board meeting to adopt a 2020 Tax Rate. Commissioner Boatright
 6. Review 2019 ESD Audit. Commissioner Boatright
 7. TML health insurance rates and strategies for the upcoming year. Chief Bancroft
 8. Review and approve disposal of surplus ESD equipment. Chiefs Bancroft and Ackerman
 9. Construction of the new Highway 71 ESD Fire Station. Chiefs Bancroft and Ackerman
- D. Commissioners will receive a report from Chief Bancroft on operational status, emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities and personnel and consider taking related action(s). Chief Bancroft

If the Board decides to enter executive session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and the provision from the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
