



Notice of Meeting – August 25, 2020

Bastrop County Emergency Services District No. 1

Pursuant to Section 551, Texas Government Code, the Bastrop County Emergency Services District No. 1 Commissioners will meet in Special Meeting, Tuesday, August 25, 2020 at the Bastrop County ESD No. 1 Central Fire and Training Facility, 1965 FM 20, Red Rock, Texas 78662. There will be discussion and action on the following items:

1. Call to order.
2. Public Comment: *In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners (Limited to two minutes)*
3. Conduct a public hearing on the proposal to increase property taxes for tax year 2020 per Chapter 26, Texas Tax Code, even though the actual tax rate will remain the same as last year.
4. Discussion and action on the adoption of Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget.

5. Discussion and action on the District's 2020 ad valorem tax rate, adopt an Order Levying Taxes and authorize filing the Order with the Bastrop County Tax Assessor/Collector and other appropriate authorities. Commissioner Boatright

The Board of Commissioners is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes. These purposes include receiving legal advice from its attorney pursuant to §551.071 of the Texas Government Code; discussing real property matters pursuant to §551.072 of the Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073 of the Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters §551.074; discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076 of the Texas Government Code. If the Board decides to enter executive session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and the provision from the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
